Skills Needed and Description of Job:

- Travels to new and established store locations in the Southeastern U.S. to set up/remodel store showroom floors.
- Schedules work assignments of subordinate personnel engaged in store display activities; reviews/approves time sheets and leave time; may instruct and train new personnel on proper protocol and procedures of the department.
- Provides training for store personnel to include merchandise placement, tagging and labeling merchandise, signage placement, etc.



- Schedules store merchandise resets as requested; assigns display associates as necessary.
- Coordinates scheduling temporary help as needed; oversees and directs work of temporary help while on company premises.
- Designs floor layout by following blueprint specifications; coordinates merchandise in order to set floor; consults with appropriate personnel as needed such as group managers, merchandising, distribution, etc.
- Selects merchandise according to specifications and examines merchandise to ensure conformance with store standards.
- Prepares merchandise for store display such as furniture, electronics, and appliances by receiving, preparing and attaching labels, signs and prices merchandise; repairs and/or reports damaged merchandise as necessary.
- Receives bids and schedules tasks such as window cleaning, debris removal/waste pickup, etc.
- **Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license and must be able to engage in weekly overnight travel Monday – Friday to established and new store locations in the Southeastern region of the U.S.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to lift and/or carry weights of twenty to fifty pounds
- Ability to plan and organize displays for stores by following blueprint specifications
- Ability to assemble and repair merchandise for display using carpentry tools
- Ability to coordinate the setup of electronics dept
- Ability to coordinate/supervise temporary staff
- Good organizational skills
